¿Debe un Católico Buscar una Anulación?

Pregunta: Después de un divorcio civil, ¿está obligado un católico a solicitar la anulación?

Respuesta:

Muchos católicos no están exactamente seguros de lo que hace una anulación. Una anulación no niega que hubo un matrimonio, ni niega que alguna vez hubo amor. No significa que las personas digan algo falso, como que nunca se amaron o que todo en su matrimonio estuvo mal. Una nulidad no niega a los hijos, ni los hace ilegítimos. Una anulación aborda el aspecto espiritual del matrimonio. En efecto, una anulación dice que, en el momento de la boda, había algo presente o algo ausente que impidió que se llevara a cabo el sacramento. Es una determinación espiritual que, si se otorga en forma afirmativa, permite que una persona se case por la Iglesia.

Las anulaciones no tienen valor legal y no pueden ser utilizadas en un tribunal civil. Por lo tanto, un católico no tiene la obligación moral de solicitar la anulación. Sin embargo, cuando ocurre la tragedia del divorcio y no hay esperanza de reconciliación, las anulaciones pueden ayudar a cerrar espiritualmente la vida de una persona. Algunas personas han encontrado que el proceso es sanador y otras lo han encontrado difícil. Habla con tu sacerdote o con un miembro del personal del Tribunal Diocesano para decidir qué es lo mejor para ti.
