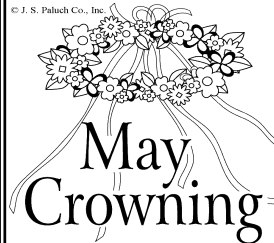

Uniting Children with Their Mothers and Fathers in Prison

Get On The Bus is a program of the Center for Restorative Justice Works (CRJW), a nonprofit organization that unites children & families separated by crime and the criminal justice system. Get On The Bus was founded in 1999 by Sr. Suzanne Jabro, CSJ. This dynamic program gathers children and their caregivers or guardians from all across California and makes it possible for them to visit their respective mothers or fathers in prison on Mothers' Day and Fathers' Day. With most parents in California prisons incarcerated at facilities more than 100 miles away from their children, many families depend on Get On the Bus to keep them connected. 50% of Get On The Bus mothers and 40% of Get On The Bus fathers report that they would never see their children without Get on the Bus. Rental of buses is extremely expensive.

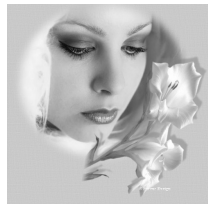
