## Dear parishioners of St. Edward,

No doubt you have heard or read of the horrific events that have been revealed by the investigative report from Pennsylvania as well as the sinful acts of Cardinal McCarrick over the years in the Catholic Church here in the USA. These events are as shocking and detestable to me as I am sure they are to you. The Catholic Church, like so many institutions, must earn and maintain sacred trust in all of its members but especially the most vulnerable: our children and elderly. That being said, I am repulsed by these recent revelations and I completely understand your frustration and anger over the complete lack of trust many priests, religious and bishops have recklessly displayed over many decades. This is totally unacceptable to me as well. As priests and deacons of St. Edward, I speak for myself, Fr. Benedict, Deacon John and Deacon Roger in absolutely committing ourselves to a safe environment and proper spiritual formation of everyone at St. Edward parish. As you are appalled by these events, I just ask that we continue to pray for the purification of our beloved Catholic Church and pray for the vast majority of good and holy clergy and religious that serve you with the utmost integrity. Although no amount of prayers can change the wrongs of the past, we must pray for the victims. We can also pray and work for a better future. I intend on being a part of that future. I invite you to be a part of it as well. Please continue to hold each other in prayer in reparation for the betrayal that the church has caused anyone and I sincerely apologize on behalf of the church. Please join me in offering a daily prayer to Saint Joseph, patron of the universal church, for the protection and renewal of the church. Below you will find the prayer recommended by our diocese.

*To you, St. Joseph we bring our broken hearts and all of the discouragement that weighs us down. Impurity and scandal have wounded our Church and have brought much shame, sorrow and tears. We ask you dearest St. Joseph, to be our guide along this very dark path, for you are the model of faith, purity and devotion that we need so desperately. May the Lord send forth the burning fire of the Holy Spirit, and renew the face of the Church, and the world. O St. Joseph, pray ceaselessly for the Church during this time of suffering and great mourning. May this current pain inflicted upon the Church be transformed by the power of Christ's cross, and lead to further renewal and continued purification. Amen.*

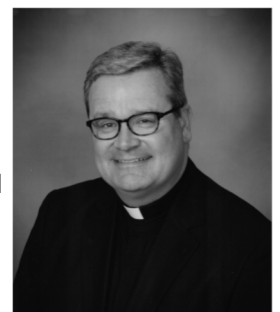
