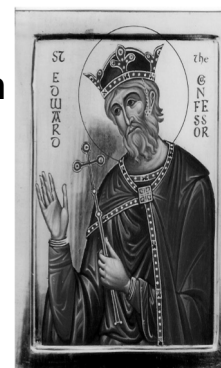
Blessing of the Animals
