**We must not pray in words only,
but with deeds.**

St Cyprian's treatise on the Lord's Prayer

Why should we be surprised, beloved brethren, that this is the nature of the prayer that God taught, seeing that he condensed all our prayer into one saving sentence of his teaching? This had already been foretold by the prophet Isaiah, who, filled with the Holy Spirit, spoke of the majesty and loving kindness of God: *completing and shortening his word in righteousness, because God will make a shortened word in the whole earth.* For when the word of God, that is, our Lord Jesus Christ, came to all of us, bringing together the learned and the unlearned, and gave the precepts of salvation to those of every age and sex, he made a compendium of his precepts, so that his pupils' memories should not be burdened by the heavenly teaching but might quickly learn what was necessary for a simple faith.

Thus, when he taught what eternal life was, he wrapped up the sacrament of life in an all-embracing and divine brevity, saying: *This is eternal life, to know you, the one true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.* And also, when he had to gather from the law and the prophets the first and greatest commandments, he said: *Hear, O Israel: the Lord your God is one God, and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your mind, and with all your strength. This is the first commandment; and the second is like it: you shall love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the law and all the*

prophets. And again: Whatever good you wish men to do to you, do it to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

It was not only in words that God taught us to pray, but in actions as well, for he himself prayed frequently and imploringly, showing us his example so that we should follow it, as it is written: *But he himself went off to a solitary place and prayed; or, He went out onto the mountain to pray, and continued all night praying to God.*

The Lord prayed and beseeched not for himself – for what reason has the guiltless one to pray for himself? – but for our sins, as he made clear when he said to Peter, *See, Satan wants to sift you as if you were wheat: but I have prayed for you so that your faith should not fail.* Later, too, he beseeches the Father for all people, saying: *I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their words: may they all be one. As you, Father, are in me, and I in you, so may they also be one in us.* God's mercy and desire for our salvation are so great that he is not content to redeem us with his blood, but also prays for us over and over again. And now you should see what it was he was praying for: that just as the Father and the Son are one, so too we should be part of that same unity.

Comentário: O Evangelho de hoje segue a mesma ideia; aí, encontramos Jesus comendo na casa de um dos chefes dos fariseus, que percebendo que os convidados procuram os primeiros lugares, conta uma parábola. Esta percepção de Jesus é mais do que nunca válida nos dias de hoje: a busca dos primeiros lugares a qualquer preço, o carreirismo, o desejo de poder, competições causadas pelo orgulho. Da boca pra fora, qualquer pessoa pode-se dizer humilde, desapegado, mas basta às vezes uma palavra para ficar ofendida e alimentar sentimentos de crítica e de vingança.

Devemos buscar os primeiros lugares sim, mas diante de Deus. E para conseguir isso, devemos fazer o contrário do que o mundo prega. O maior diante de Deus é aquele que se faz menor: “quem se eleva será humilhado, e quem se humilha será elevado”.

Mas, então, o que significa fazer-se último? Não significa, certamente, enterrar os próprios talentos, fugir das responsabilidades. Não! A menos que sejamos impedidos, devemos fazer com que frutifiquem ao máximo. Temos que dar o nosso melhor para o bem dos outros, não, porém, para nos sentirmos melhores que os outros. Fazer-se humilde significa libertar-se da ânsia da estima humana e ter serena consciência de que cada um de nós tem valor para Deus. A verdadeira humildade é esta verdade, esta serenidade. Santo

Cura d’Ars dá seu testemunho: “eu recebi duas cartas muito fortes, uma me dizia que eu era um grande santo, outra que eu era um hipócrita. A primeira não me acrescentou nada, a segunda não tirou nada de mim, diante de Deus somos aquilo que somos e nada mais”.

Enfim, Jesus nos convida à virtude da gratuidade, “quando deres um almoço ou um jantar, convida os pobres, os aleijados, os coxos, os cegos”. Hoje, os relacionamentos são quase sempre feitos em vista do proveito próprio, do interesse. Fazer-se humilde significa por o pensamento primeiramente no servir: é grande quem serve, quem doa, quem entra no mistério do amor. O humilde é um incansável servo do próximo: o humilde sente que tudo é dom de Deus e tem pressa de doar tudo, porque aquilo que não se doa, perde. O humilde trabalha, age, serve, mas não espera recompensa. Poder servir é já a recompensa. Mesmo que ninguém agradeça. É muito importante ser humilde e amar o próximo desinteressadamente, sobretudo onde se há mais necessidade e onde se é menos visto, “então tu serás feliz”. Pe Carlos Henrique Nascimento
