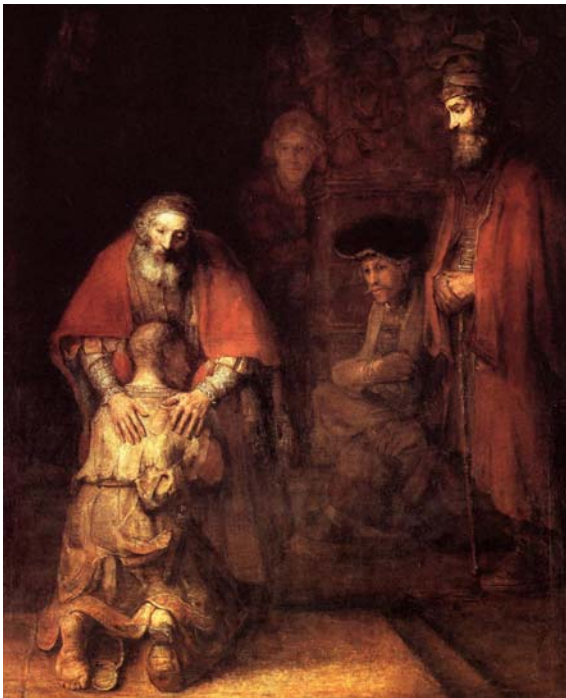

God, the Father of Mercy



We have a father who delights in showing mercy. Twice he leaves his house to bestow extravagant love to his children. If he had stayed home he would have had one dead child and one ungrateful servant. Instead he wanted two sons. So he does the unexpected. He sees a sinful child still far off and he is filled with compassion. Not waiting for the child to come to him, he goes first, to protect him from the judgment of those who condemn sinners, and second to bestow gifts of mercy, freedom and honor. For the second son he leaves the celebration to make clear that the invitation is to sinners, to those who because of pride remain distant, and to those on the outside who do not feel welcome at the feast. It is Jesus who has left the house of heaven, and is outside with us, inviting us and all sinners to the life he came to give. And to make clear that there is nothing that will separate us from the love of God.

St. Gaspar wants us to experience this immeasurable generosity of God. He adds words like "ineffable benefit," "august mystery," and "flaming outburst" to describe the inexpressible Love of God. He wants us to experience the depths of this love that we might learn to love without measure.

august mystery, together with incarnation of the Son of God, was a flaming outburst of love: "he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave" (*Phil 2:7*) His submission to so many pains and trials was a flaming outburst of love to leave himself of Calvary. It was a flaming outburst of love to leave himself entirely in the Eucharistic banquet. It was a flaming outburst of love for him to find his delight in us miserable creatures: "rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the human race," (*Prov. 8:31*) and that burning wish of his for our eternal salvation in the beloved homeland of heaven. Oh soul, plunge yourself deeply into these moving thoughts and you cannot help but repeat with the Apostle: "The love of Christ impels us!" (*2 Cor 5:14*) It is not so much what Jesus suffered as it is the love that he demonstrated in his suffering for us that obliges us and even forces us to love him in return." COMENTÁRIO O Evangelho de hoje nos apresenta três parábolas. Cada vez que lemos e releemos a mesma parábola, e este ano já é a segunda vez que lemos a do “filho pródigo”, descobrimos novos significados que nos guiam em nosso amadurecimento humano. A novidade das parábolas de Jesus é aquela de enxergar sempre as coisas do ponto de vista de Deus; Jesus nos revela o modo de pensar de Deus que frequentemente é completamente diferente do modo como nós, apesar de ouvirmos tantas vezes as mesmas parábolas, insistimos em não assumir o caráter de Deus em nós.

Por exemplo, diante do pecador, Jesus nunca dá ênfase a este apontando o seu erro, mas ele sempre ressalta a beleza do amor de Deus que busca o pecador para perdô-lo. E a grande beleza proveniente destas parábolas é que cabe a cada um de nós em primeiro lugar reconhecer-se pecador para sentir esse amor incondicional e em segundo lugar ir atrás das “ovelhas perdidas, da moeda perdida, do filho pródigo” para que também experimentem desse amor que nos preenche completamente. Essa tarefa é exatamente o contrário do gesto de apontar o defeito do outro, de julgar e de condenar.

Já expliquei o evangelho do filho pródigo este ano durante a quaresma e ressaltei que nas duas primeiras parábolas de Lc 15, a iniciativa é sempre de Deus, já que nem a ovelha nem a moeda têm como voltar pra seus donos por si só. Já a parábola dos dois filhos, é o filho pródigo quem começa o caminho de volta, mas antes que chegue, é o pai que quando o avista, corre ao seu encontro, o abraça e o cobre de beijos. Esta iniciativa do filho de retornar é para mostrar que somente é possível receber este amor de Deus se deixarmos de ser cabeças-duras e nos abriremos a este amor. Já a reação do filho maior revela ainda a atitude dos fariseus: inveja, raiva, presunção, superioridade em relação aos outros. Ele chega a dizer ao pai: “este teu filho”, como se não fosse irmão dele.

Com as parábolas de hoje, Deus nos chama a pararmos de nos esconder, de reconhecermos abertamente o impostor que vive em nós (filho mais velho) e nos aproximarmos dele como o filho mais novo.

Por isso, a partir daqui cito algumas frases de livros do padre Brennan Manning, que dá o seu testemunho acerca de seus problemas com o alcoolismo e sua dificuldade em aceitar ser aceito por Deus:

“Uma das contradições mais chocantes da Igreja é a profunda aversão que muitos discípulos de Jesus nutrem por si mesmos. Estão mais insatisfeitos com as próprias falhas do que jamais imaginariam estar em relação às de qualquer outra pessoa.

Nos meus oito anos de idade, nasceu em mim, como forma de defesa contra o sofrimento, o impostor, ou o falso eu. O impostor que vive em mim sussurrava: “Brennan, jamais seja quem você de fato é, porque ninguém gosta de você como é. Invente um novo eu a que todos admirem e ninguém conheça”. Tornei-me assim um bom menino: cortês, educado, discreto e respeitoso. Estudei com afinco, tirei as melhores notas, granjeei uma bolsa de estudos para o ensino médio, e a cada momento fui perseguido pelo pavor do abandono e da sensação de não ter ninguém ao meu lado. 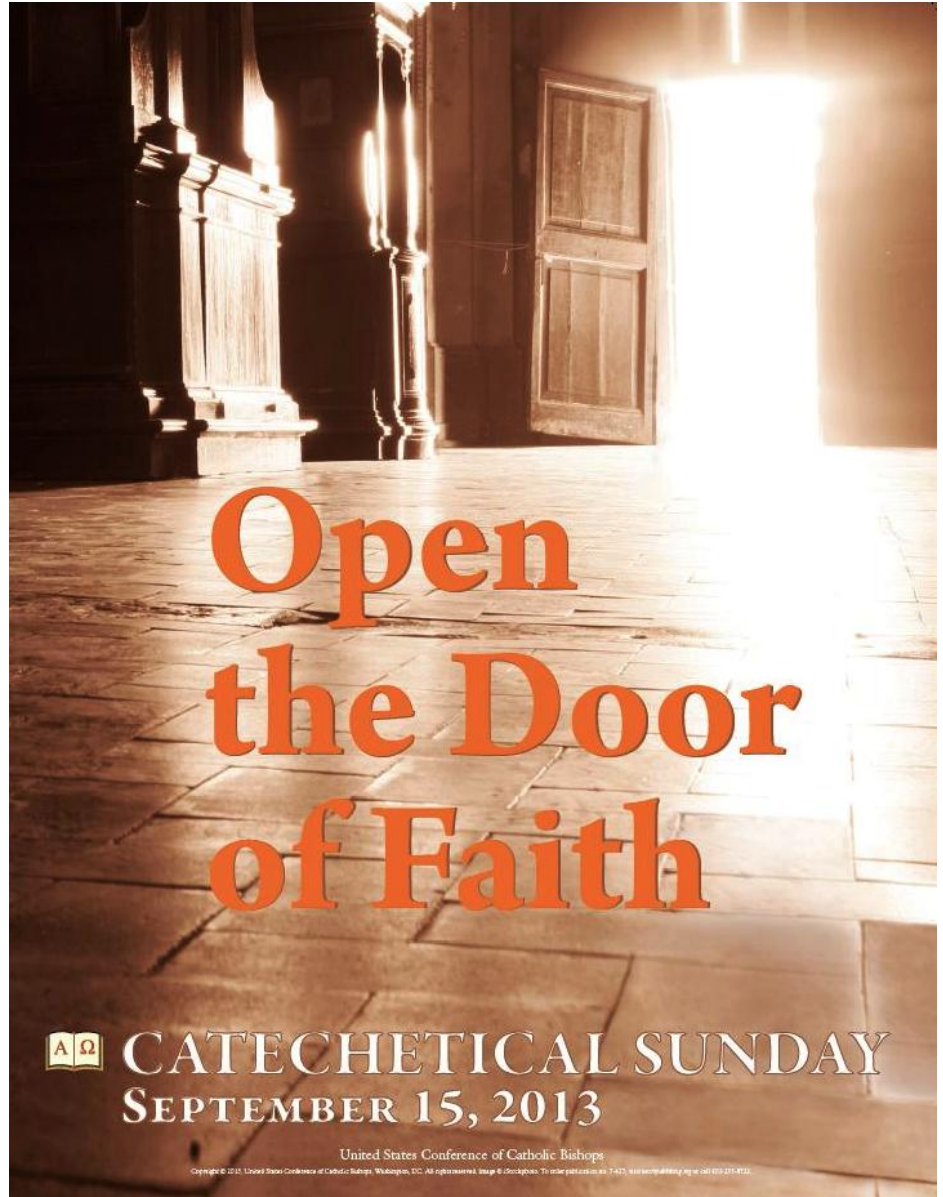
