## The Christian is another Christ

### A treatise on Christian Perfection by St Gregory of Nyssa

More than anyone, St Paul understood who Christ is and those requirements needed by the person named after him. Paul spoke of what he himself had accomplished and accurately imitated him in a manner to show the Lord expressed in his own person. By careful imitation Paul became a model so that it is no longer he who is perceived as living and speaking, but Christ who lives in him. Knowing his own blessings, that good man said *You seek proof that Christ is speaking in me* and, elsewhere, *It is no longer I who live but Christ who lives in me.*

Paul's words show us the significance of Christ's name, when he said that Christ is the power and wisdom of God. But he also called Christ: peace; the inaccessible light where God dwells; our sanctification and redemption; the great high priest; our Passover and our sacrifice of expiation; the brightness of glory; the very image of God's substance; the creator of the ages; our spiritual food and drink; the rock and the water; the foundation of faith; the chief cornerstone; the image of the great and invisible God; the head of his body, the Church; the first-born of the new creation and the first-fruits

of those who have fallen asleep; the first-born from the dead, the first-born among many brothers; the mediator between God and man; the only-begotten Son crowned with honor and glory; the Lord of glory; the beginning of all things; the King of justice, but not only of justice but also the King of peace and the King of all things, the King whose kingdom is boundless.

Paul gave all these names to Christ and many others too: so many that they cannot easily be counted. But they are all related, and if you understand the meaning of each of them on its own and put those meanings together then you will come to understand the full meaning of that one word "Christ" and that will show you – as far as the human soul is able to comprehend it – God's inexpressible greatness.

The good Lord has granted us the privilege of sharing in this, the greatest, most divine and chief of all names, so that, honored by the name of Christ, we are called "Christians." So then we must ensure that in us are seen all the meanings of the name of Christ, so that our title is not false and meaningless but is borne out by our lives.

## Sacred Relics Of The Saints: Treasures Of The Church

St. Edward's Parish presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Tuesday, November 5, at 7:00 pm. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with his very special ministry to teach about these holy objects. He will bring with him over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. In the Church's history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. Please do not miss this opportunity. ## BOLETIM PORTUGUÊS MISSA DOMINGO XXVI DO TEMPO COMUM



Comentário: Muitas pessoas apostam que a plenitude da vida e da felicidade se encontra na riqueza; basta olhar a correria de pessoas por empregos ou negócios que ofereçam enormes salários, e sempre insatisfeitas com o que vão conquistando. É a diabólica pedagogia que tem dividido o nosso mundo em milhões de “lázaros”, obrigados a catar lixo, a comer sobejos que caem das mesas dos ricos, ou morrer de fome. Uma pedagogia que, infelizmente, parece ter se transformado em religião no nosso mundo e que é uma das razões dos piores males da humanidade. Que, pelo menos, temos uma notícia boa este ano, segundo a ONU, o número de famintos crônicos diminuiu 9,6%. Em 2009, eram mais de 1,02 bilhão de pessoas que sofriam de fome crônica, a este são 925 milhões. Ainda assim, é uma vergonha não ter se extinguido por completo a fome e a miséria num mundo cada vez mais cheio de cifras bilionárias.

O ser rico não é mais um sonho de alguns que ficavam observando a fabulosa vida que leva quem chegou a ser um “tio patinhas” da vida, mas se tornou uma verdadeira obsessão, que ameaça cancelar os verdadeiros desejos do coração, aqueles que Deus inspira e tem como sonho “amar até doar-se em plenitude”. Infelizmente, parece que é a fábula do momento: uma fábula cultivada de tantas revistas e livros especializados em como “enriquecer juntos”, “o segredo das mentes milionárias” etc, sem por um único momento, pensar que atrás da fachada de luxo e ostentado bem estar, muitas vezes está uma tristeza que é sinal do vazio do coração. Nada pode dar a verdadeira felicidade se não o amor que se faz dom e não posses.

A estes, e a quantos querem ser como eles, escreve o profeta Amós na I leitura, quando faz uma forte denúncia à injustiça daqueles que levam uma vida luxuosa à custa da exploração dos pobres, sendo totalmente indiferentes ao sofrimento e miséria destes. Para eles, Amós anuncia que Deus não vai tolerar este egoísmo, reservando-lhes um final infeliz: serão deportados de seu país “na primeira fila”.

Também Lucas continua a denunciar o mau uso do dinheiro por parte de alguns à custa da miséria de tantos. Na parábola do homem rico e do miserável Lázaro, Jesus descreve a vida terrena de ambos: os dois extremos da sociedade. O rico tem um estilo de vida alto, suas roupas são das grifes mais caras, elegantes e luxuosas. Ele usa a sua riqueza para levar uma vida cheia de prazeres. O sentido da vida pra ele é o prazer das coisas materiais. O

que o separa do miserável Lázaro é apenas a porta de sua casa. Ele não acolhe o pobre. Este leva uma vida dura; não só é desprovido de bens, mas se encontra doente e desabrigado. Seu corpo não é coberto de roupas finas, mas de muitas feridas. Ele quer matar sua fome com o sobejo da mesa do rico. Sua companhia são os cães sujos que se aproximam dele para lambe-lhe as feridas. Faminto e doente, vive na sujeira das ruas. Mas, diferentemente do rico, Jesus faz questão de lembrar o seu nome: Lázaro (Deus ajuda).

Na extrema pobreza, ele não perde a confiança, mas é convicto de que Deus o ajuda.

Morre o miserável, único instrumento de salvação do rico. Morre também o rico. A morte os torna iguais. Não há como escapar dela. E a este ponto, o destino deles se inverte completamente. O que é descrito sobre a vida depois da morte dos protagonistas da parábola não quer ser uma descrição precisa da vida eterna; mas quer caracterizar a radical diversidade entre a vida daquele que um tempo foi rico e a do que foi pobre. Lázaro é levado para o seio de Abraão, para o banquete festivo. Quanto ao rico, dois elementos mostram como mudou a sua situação. Ele que vivia no luxo, agora é rodeado de fogo e grandes tormentos. Ele que tinha a sua disposição comidas finas e bebidas importadas, agora implora por uma simples gota d’água. Na vida terrena, Lázaro faminto tinha lhe pedido os restos da sua mesa sem receber nada. Agora, é o rico que pede uma gota d’água na ponta do dedo de Lázaro e não pode recebê-la. Tarde demais! O modo no qual empregou sua riqueza e consumou a sua vida o reduziu a uma condição na qual sofre dor e tormento. Pe Carlos Henrique Nascimento
