## **A letter to the Trallians by St Ignatius of Antioch**

Ignatius, also called Theophorus, to the holy church at Tralles in the province of Asia, dear to God the Father of Jesus Christ, elect and worthy of God, enjoying peace in body and in the Spirit through the passion of Jesus Christ, who is our hope through our resurrection when we rise to him. In the manner of the apostles, I too send greetings to you with the fullness of grace and extend my every best wish.

Reports of your splendid character have reached me: how you are beyond reproach and ever unshaken in your patient endurance – qualities that you have not acquired but are yours by nature. My informant was your own bishop Polybius, who by the will of God and Jesus Christ visited me here in Smyrna. He so fully entered into my joy at being in chains for Christ that I came to see your whole community embodied in him. Moreover, when I learned from him of your God-given kindness toward me, I broke out in words of praise for God. It is on him, I discovered, that you pattern your lives.

Your submission to your bishop, who is in the place of Jesus Christ, shows me that you are not

living as men usually do but in the manner of Jesus himself, who died for us that you might escape death by belief in his death. Thus one thing is necessary, and you already observe it, that you do nothing without your bishop; indeed, be subject to the clergy as well, seeing in them the apostles of Jesus Christ our hope, for if we live in him we shall be found in him.

Deacons, too, who are ministers of the mysteries of Jesus should in all things be pleasing to all men. For they are not mere servants with food and drink, but emissaries of God's Church; hence they should guard themselves against anything deserving reproach as they would against fire.

Similarly, all should respect the deacons as Jesus Christ, just as all should regard the bishop as the image of the Father, and the clergy as God's senate and the college of the apostles. Without these three orders you cannot begin to speak of a church. I am confident that you share my feelings in this matter, for I have had an example of your love in the person of your bishop who is with me now. His whole bearing is a great lesson, and his very gentleness wields a mighty influence.

By God's grace there are many things I understand, but I keep well within my limitations for fear that boasting should be my undoing. At the moment, then, I must be more apprehensive than ever and pay no attention at all to those who flatter me; their praise is as a scourge. For though I have a fierce desire to suffer martyrdom, I know not whether I am worthy of it. Most people are unaware of my passionate longing, but it assails me with increasing intensity. My present need, then, is for that humility by which the prince of this world is overthrown.

And so I strongly urge you, not I so much as the love of Jesus Christ, to be nourished exclusively on Christian fare, abstaining from the alien food that is heresy. And this you will do if you are neither arrogant nor cut off from God, from Jesus Christ, and from the bishop and the teachings of the apostles. Whoever is within the sanctuary is pure; but whoever is not is unclean. That is to say, whoever acts apart from the bishop and the clergy and the deacons is not pure in his conscience. In writing this, it is not that I am aware of anything of the sort among you; I only wish to forewarn you, for you are my dearest children.

## BOLETIM PORTUGUÊS MISSA DOMINGO XXVII DO TEMPO COMUM



Comentário: A Palavra de Deus que hoje nos é dirigida fala de dois temas: a fé e a atitude correta que o homem deve assumir perante Deus. As leituras são um convite a reconhecermos nossa pequenez e a acolher com gratidão os dons que Deus nos concede.

Na primeira parte do Evangelho, vemos um pedido por parte dos apóstolos ao Senhor: “aumenta a nossa fé!”. Não sabemos precisamente o que tenha feito os apóstolos pedirem ao Senhor para que aumentasse a fé deles; podemos imaginar que seja algo ligado ao perdão ilimitado (texto imediatamente anterior): por ser uma tarefa muito difícil, principalmente quando se tem que perdoar o próximo que nos magoa constantemente; às vezes, a paciência e o amor querem fraquejar. Por isso, é necessária muita fé.

Os apóstolos e nós, hoje, nos damos conta como é fraca a nossa fé em Deus. Mas, como eles, não abandonamos a luta nem diminuímos os nossos trabalhos, mas pedimos ao Senhor uma fé mais firme. E é o que devemos fazer mesmo! Só Deus pode vir em nosso auxílio.

Jesus não responde diretamente ao pedido dos apóstolos. Mas, com a sua resposta, ressalta a importância da fé. Somente se tivermos uma autêntica confiança em Deus, acontecerá aquilo que para a razão humana é impossível. Esta impossibilidade é exemplificada através da imagem do “transportar montanhas” (aqui uma amoreira). Não há limites para o poder de Deus. Mesmo que Deus nos peça coisas aparentemente impossíveis, ele pode nos tornar capazes de realizá-las. E mesmo que esta fé seja microscópica como uma pequena semente de mostarda, se for verdadeira fé, Deus fará com que ela desenvolva. (contraste entre a pequenez da semente de mostarda de 2mm de diâmetro e a altura dessa árvore de até 5 metros de altura).

Na I leitura, vemos o profeta Habacuc que discute com Deus: como fazer pra acreditar em Deus se as coisas estão indo mal? E Deus responde: “o justo viverá por sua fé”. Talvez estejamos na mesma situação de Habacuc? Quanta violência, injustiças, tragédias, e quanta falta de fé. É preciso termos fé, é necessário confiar.

Em tudo aquilo que Jesus faz, ele encoraja os apóstolos a serem. Ele diz a Pedro: “eu orei por ti para que tua fé não desfaleça” (Lc 22,32). Desta forma, o Senhor cumpre o pedido feito por seus apóstolos de aumentar a fé deles. Também nós devemos contar com a oração de Jesus e pedir esta forma de relação fundamental com Deus: a confiança nele.

Com a parábola do servo, Jesus nos indica um outro aspecto essencial da nossa relação com Deus. Esta parábola não pretende mostrar o comportamento de Deus com relação ao homem, mas quer indicar qual a justa atitude em que nos encontramos perante ele. Jesus não quer passar a ideia de um Deus como um patrão que manda, é servido sem agradecer, e alimenta os seus servos só com o resto! Não! O que importa aqui é: qual a justa visão que os apóstolos devem ter de sua relação com Deus: os servos devem fazer tudo aquilo que o seu patrão ordena. Observando estas ordens, fazem somente o seu dever e não merecem nada por isso. Devem aceitar esta realidade. Pe Carlos Henrique Nascimento
