St Ignatius of Antioch's letter to the Trallians

Take on meekness. Be renewed in faith, which is the flesh of the Lord, and in love, which is the blood of Jesus Christ. Let none of you have a grudge against his neighbour. Give no occasion to the heathen: do not let the congregation of God be blasphemed because of the behaviour of a few foolish persons. For *Woe to him who makes anyone blaspheme my name without a cause.*

Be deaf therefore when anyone preaches to you without mentioning Jesus Christ, who was of the family of David, who was truly born of Mary, who truly ate and drank, was truly persecuted under Pontius Pilate, was truly crucified and died in the sight of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth; who was also truly raised from the dead, when his Father raised him up — just as his Father will raise us up, believers in Christ Jesus without whom we have no true life.

Flee from these preachers, these wicked offshoots that bear deadly fruit, one taste of which is

fatal. These have not been planted by the Father; if they had been, they would grow as branches of the Cross and their fruit would be incorruptible. Through the Cross he calls you, who are parts of his own body, to himself. A head cannot come into being alone, without the rest of the body; for God promises unity, as he himself is unity.

I greet you from Smyrna together with the Churches of God that are present with me, men who in all things have given me solace in the flesh and in the spirit. I carry my chains for the sake of Jesus Christ, praying that I may attain to God; and these chains appeal to you to continue in your present harmony and in prayer with one another. For it is right that each of you, and especially the presbyters, should give the bishop peace of mind, to the honor of the Father, of Jesus Christ, and of the Apostles. I appeal to you to listen to me in love, so that this letter can never be used in evidence against you. And pray for me also, for I have need of your love in the mercy of God, that I may be granted the lot which I am set to obtain, and not be rejected.

The love of the Smyrnaeans and Ephesians greets you: remember in your prayers the Church in Syria, of which I am the most undeserving member. Farewell in Jesus Christ. Submit yourselves to the bishop as you would to God's commandments, submit to the clergy likewise. Let each of you individually love one another with an undivided heart. My spirit is consecrated to you not only now, but also when I reach the presence of God. I am still in peril, but the Father can be trusted in Jesus Christ to fulfill both your prayers and mine. May you be found blameless in Christ.

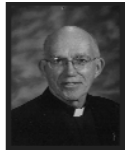

In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. 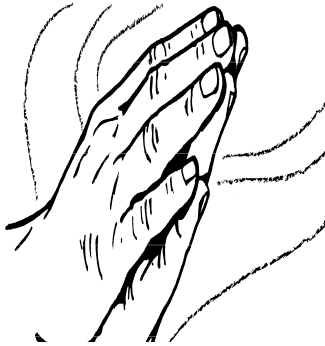

BOLETIM PORTUGUÊS MISSA DOMINGO XXIX DO TEMPO COMUM



COMENTÁRIO Pode acontecer que na nossa vida nos questionemos: será que a oração funciona mesmo? Será que Deus escuta mesmo quem reza? Estas perguntas aparecem quando Deus parece não reagir diante da nossa súplica ou quando não nos damos conta de sua ação, como por exemplo, quando fazemos uma oração fervorosa, e depois de obtida a graça, não a consideramos como fruto da oração. E isto nos leva a pensar que se a oração for realmente inútil, para que perdermos tanto tempo com ela?

Justamente por causa dessas dúvidas, é que a liturgia dominical insiste tanto em tratar o tema da oração. O Evangelho quer mostrar o quanto a oração é essencial na vida do cristão, através de relatos onde o próprio Jesus reza ou quando ele nos orienta na prática da oração. Ele diz que pra que nossa oração seja eficaz, nós devemos: amar os nossos inimigos e rezar pelos que nos perseguem, rezar ao Pai “no segredo”, perdoar do fundo do nosso coração a quem nos ofendeu, rezar com audácia na certeza do obter e com plena adesão à vontade de Deus.

Na I leitura de hoje, vemos o esforço de Moisés em manter a mão levantada para vencer a batalha; no Evangelho, com a parábola da viúva importuna, Jesus nos exorta à paciência da fé, necessária quando nossa oração parece não ouvida e inútil.

No tempo de Jesus, a mulher viúva ficava numa situação muito difícil, sem meios para viver e sem proteção. A viúva do relato de Jesus tem necessidade de ser defendida e por isso, se dirige ao juiz. Mas, o juiz de sua cidade não tem interesse algum em ouvi-la. Pois, ele sabe que aquela pobre mulher não pode lhe pagar um preço alto e ele não quer perder seu tempo por uma causa que não dê muito lucro. Ele não se importa de maneira alguma com a situação da viúva, é totalmente indiferente, e recusa ouvi-la.

A viúva, porém, não perde a esperança: todos os dias, volta a se apresentar ao juiz, repetindo sempre a mesma coisa: “faze-me justiça contra o meu adversário!”. Os dias passam e o juiz já não agüenta mais aquela viúva importuna. Por um tempo, ele até faz de conta não se incomodar, mas um dia ele cansa de ouvir aquele aborrecimento e pensa: “mesmo não temendo a Deus nem respeitando ninguém, não suporto mais esta viúva me torrando a paciência, e por isso, vou fazer-lhe justiça para que ela me deixe em paz”.

Muitas vezes nos comportamos exatamente como esse juiz, e por isso, entendemos bem a parábola: a quem nos pede um favor que não queremos fazer, damos um sim pra ficarmos livres, que no final das contas, fazemos pensando em nós mesmos. Um comportamento destes não é próprio do coração de Deus.

Jesus termina de contar a parábola e pergunta aos discípulos: “você ouviram o que diz este juiz injusto? Pois bem, se até mesmo um juiz desonesto decide atender uma viúva para não ser mais incomodado por ela, como pensam que se comportará Deus que é Pai com relação aos filhos que imploram a ele? Eu lhes digo que Deus fará justiça bem depressa”.

Se não rezarmos, estamos dizendo a Deus que ele é impotente. É necessário que rezemos pacientemente, incessantemente. Entretanto, nós temos de ser conscientes de que não podemos prescrever quando e como ele nos atenderá. Uma coisa sabemos: ele nos fará justiça. Deus pode nos provar por um longo tempo, mas também pode intervir de modo rápido e inesperado.
