It Is a Holy Thought to Pray for the Dead A sermon by St Gregory Nazianzen

What is man, that you are mindful of him? What is this new mystery surrounding me? I am both small and great, both lowly and exalted, mortal and immortal, earthly and heavenly. I am to be buried with Christ and to rise again with him, to become a co-heir with him, a son of God, and indeed God himself.

This is what the great mystery means for us; this is why God became man and became poor for our sake: it was to raise up our flesh, to recover the divine image, to re-create mankind, so that all of us might become one in Christ who perfectly became in us everything that he is himself. So we are no longer to be *male and female, barbarian and Scythian, slave and free* – distinctions deriving from the flesh – but are to bear within ourselves only the seal of God, by whom and for whom we were created. We are to be so formed and molded by him that we are recognised as belonging to his one family.

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Seals featuring the patron saint of a city, monastic foundation or parish church have a long history in the ceremonial and symbolic life of the Catholic Church. In this instance, the English king St. Edward the Confessor is shown at the center of the device; his appearance is derived from traditional depictions in general and the parish's patronal statue in particular. He holds a scepter topped with a dove in one hand; a similar object remains part of the British monarch's ceremonial regalia, and is called the "rod of Equity and Mercy. In his other, he holds a small stylized model of the parish church, representing his role as its protector. To the left is a shield bearing a variant version of the arms traditionally attributed to him; while an anachronistic creation of later heralds, they nonetheless are based on a design featured on a coin from his reign. Usually, it is shown as a cross between five birds, but as here, four are occasionally seen as an alternative; this is closer to the original coin design, and makes for a more legible and balanced element in the small confines of the seal. The crown's crosses and fleurs-de-lis are a common feature of most English royal crowns. The right-hand shield, showing a chalice on a background of drops of blood and topped with the crown of thorns, represents St. Gaspar del Bufalo and the Missionaries of the Precious Blood.

Instead, may we set out eagerly for that everlasting and blessed life which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

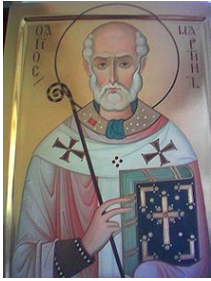

Missa Domingo XXXII Do Tempo Comum

BOLETIM PORTUGUÊS MISSA DOMINGO XXXII DO TEMPO COMUM



Comentário: Na liturgia deste domingo perpassa a confissão de fé na ressurreição dos mortos e na vida eterna, pois o Deus dos cristãos "não é um Deus de mortos, mas de vivos".

Na primeira leitura, "sete irmãos", fiéis ao Deus de Israel, o Deus dos vivos, preferem ser torturados e mortos sob a autoridade da rei da Síria, que perseguia os judeus, do que infringir as suas leis religiosas. Os irmãos confessaram a sua fé na ressurreição dos mortos, de vários modos. Todos, porém, afirmaram que a vida presente é efémera e que "vale a pena morrer às mãos dos homens, porque têm esperança em Deus de que Ele os ressuscitará para a vida eterna". E nós, somos capazes de defender, com verdade e rectidão, aquilo em que acreditamos?

Na terceira leitura, Lucas relata-nos o facto de alguns saduceus se terem aproximado de Jesus, a fim de o interrogarem sobre a vida futura. "Havia sete irmãos" que casaram sucessivamente com a viúva sem deixarem descendentes. "De qual destes será ela esposa na ressurreição, uma vez que os sete a tiveram por mulher?". Sabemos que a obrigação de uma viúva casar sucessivamente com os irmãos do primeiro marido até obterem descendência, decorria de uma lei de Moisés, chamada Lei do Levirato. Sabemos, igualmente, que o grupo dos saduceus não acreditava na ressurreição dos mortos. De facto, é uma cilada que eles lhe lançam. Jesus, porém, aproveita a ocasião para nos transmitir um ensinamento da máxima importância para a nossa vida humana e cristã sobre a ressurreição dos mortos. Hoje, há muitas

vidas sem sentido, porque as pessoas não acreditam na vida futura em Deus, que dá uma direcção ao que vivemos e fazemos, uma direcção que nos aponta para o além, para a vida eterna. Porém, a certeza da ressurreição não deve ser, apenas, uma realidade que esperamos, mas uma realidade que influencia, desde já, a nossa existência terrena, de modo a que o novo céu e a nova terra, que nos esperam, comecem a desenhar-se desde já. Em que acreditamos nós, cristãos, a respeito da vida futura? "Cremos na ressurreição da carne e na vida eterna", confessamos nós no Credo. Esta fé conduz-nos à prática da caridade e das boas obras e, sobretudo, a uma imensa confiança em Deus que nos criou para a vida sem fim, para a vida feliz, nele?

Na segunda leitura Paulo convida-nos a manter o diálogo e a comunhão com Deus, enquanto esperamos que chegue a segunda vinda de Cristo e a vida nova que Deus nos reserva. Só com a oração será possível mantermo-nos fiéis ao Evangelho e ter a coragem de anunciar a todos as pessoas a Boa Nova da salvação. Tenho consciência de que é da oração que brota a minha fidelidade ao Evangelho, ou considero que as minhas vitórias e conquistas, neste campo, se devem apenas a mim, aos meus méritos e qualidades? - **Irmã Deolinda Serralheiro**
